House Building Booming - But for How Long?

House building approvals have surged over the second half of 2020, clearly driven by the federal governments HomeBuilder Initiative that provided a \$25,000 grant to eligible applicants towards the construction of a new house.

The Initial HomeBuilder offering expired on Dec 31 2020; however, the federal government has extended the policy to March 31 2021 but with a reduced grant of \$15,000.

Building approvals for houses Increased by 14.6% over 2020 compared to 2019 with 117,721 recorded nationally - the highest annual total since 2015.

Although the end of the HomeBuilder grant will reduce housing construction albeit from high levels, demand in the shorter-term will be supported by a reviving economy, sustained low Interest rates and strong general housing market activity.

The longer term outlook for new housing remains problematic - particularly given unprecedented declines in migration clearly Impacting population growth

Market Insights

ABS house building approvals finished 2020 with more strong results, as all capitals continued to report sharp increases in activity.

Perth was the top annual performer with a remarkable Increase of 34.4% over the year followed by Brisbane up 14.5%, Melbourne up 13.3%, Adelaide up 11.9% and Sydney where house building approvals Increased by 7.2% over 2020.

Building approval numbers In Perth were second only to Melbourne over the final three months of 2020 - with Melbourne maintaining Its clear lead over all other capitals.

Sydney reported an average building cost per house of \$365,217 over 2020 an annual increase of 1.6% with Melbourne \$362,087 down 1.7%, Brisbane \$296,785 – up 1.0%, Adelaide \$268,361 - down 0.6% and Perth \$291,630 – down 1.5%
